



The White Ribbon Alliance (WRA) ([www.whiteribbonalliance.org](http://www.whiteribbonalliance.org)) is a global network of maternal health advocates campaigning for more resources and the right policies to prevent the deaths of women in pregnancy and childbirth, while holding governments and politicians to account for their promises of action.

WRA seeks a Research and Evaluation Intern to work with staff of the Global Secretariat from October – December 2017. Applications are welcomed from students with an interest in human rights, advocacy, research, and strategic planning. A background in maternal health is not required but is helpful. This is a valuable opportunity to gain experience and contacts in international advocacy and global health fields.

**Location:** Washington, D.C.

**Responsibilities:** The Research and Evaluation Intern will work primarily on WRA's [Self-Care campaigns](#) which are new and innovative approaches to improving maternal, newborn and child health. Because the project is new to WRA's campaigns, the scope of work will include researching, collating impact reports and then drafting a guideline and report focused on the accomplishments of the self-care campaign. Specifically the impact reports will focus on programs based in Bangladesh, Zimbabwe, and Bolivia. The intern may be assigned other ad-hoc projects as they arise.

**Qualifications:**

- Excellent writing, verbal and research skills;
- A basic understanding of monitoring and evaluation;
- An interest in business/community planning;
- Strong problem-solving skills;
- Ability to work well independently and in groups with minimal supervision;
- Ability to communicate effectively with diverse international groups and organizations;
- Strong interest in international advocacy work around human rights;
- Proficient in Windows environment (Access, Word, Excel, PowerPoint);
- Experience with survey software and foreign language skills a plus (Spanish & Arabic);
- Bachelor's Degree in related field; Graduate students or degrees preferred.

**Hours and Stipend:**

- Interns will work approximately 10-20 hours per week. This part-time internship has flexible hours and end date, as well as, a small stipend of \$12.50/hour. Start date will be early-October.
