WRA seeks a part-time **Data and Advocacy Campaign Intern** to work with the Global Secretariat from **February–June 2019** for [What Women Want](#) – a global campaign dedicated to improving quality maternal and reproductive healthcare for women and girls and strengthen health systems. This campaign, a partnership of over 300 organizations, is convened and organized by WRA and sets out to query over one million women and girls about their top priority for quality health services.

Location: Washington, D.C.

Responsibilities: This position will support the *What Women Want* campaign with data management, systems development and partnership outreach. Essential to the success of the campaign is collection, cleaning, and analysis of data utilizing qualitative data analysis software. This position will work across the Programs and Advocacy and Communications teams. The intern may be assigned other ad-hoc projects as they arise.

Qualifications:

- Experience using qualitative data analysis software (e.g. NVivo) strongly preferred
- Excellent attention to detail
- Strong track record of systems management
- Strong interest/knowledge of advocacy campaigns and outreach
- Ability to work independently and take initiative
- Ability to communicate effectively with diverse international groups and organizations
- Strong interest in international advocacy work and health
- Proficient in Windows environment (Access, Word, Excel, PowerPoint)
- Fluency in Spanish, French or Hindi is a plus

Hours and Stipend:

- Interns will work approximately 15-20 hours per week. This part-time internship has flexible hours and end date, as well as, a small stipend of \$13.25/hour. Start date will be as soon possible.
